## PRE-STORM ACTIVITIES (JULY 1<sup>ST</sup>)

Buy 10 cases of bottled water
Buy 4 BIG bags of beef jerky
Buy Peanut Butter Crackers
Cat food, Cat litter & setup spare litter box and scooper
Dog food, crate, blanket, leash, toys
Charge EMERGENCY RADIO (NOAA)
Important papers in Plastic Tote
Buy protein bars, raisins, pasta, pasta sauce, etc.
Buy Tuna Fish & REMEMBER a manual can opener
Have some available CASH
Run generator 30 minutes and put a load on it.
Fill four (4) 5-gallon gasoline cans
Fill propane tanks (4 tanks for a family of four)
Batteries in a Ziploc bag
Safe Candles and lighters* (if necessary)
Headlight flashlights and outlet lights
Ponchos and battery operated fans (4)
Check small AC unit and gather UL rated extension cords
Identify shelter locations and apps on phone
CO Detector, Smoke Detector (batteries)
Video/Pictures of personal your belongings & Document
Box fan & cords
Spare fuses for each vehicle
Create a Family Communications Plan
Identify Animal Shelters; especially for elderly residents









#### **STORM IN ATLANTIC PLANNING**

Start Generator and fill it up
Check small AC unit and gather UL rated extension cords
Verify Beef Jerky, Tuna, Protein Bars any other foods,
pre-packed salami/ham/cheese, Gatorade
Buy 6 pasta and 6 jar sauce, buy some burgers/dogs and
freeze
Start eating perishable stuff out of the freezer. Ice cream etc
Freeze some Tupperware for BLOCK ICE
Check Propane tanks
Gather important papers and put in a plastic Ziploc
Copies of Medical History
Gather Medications (refill prescriptions)
Gather Toiletries
Gather Phone Chargers
8 ROLLS of Toilet paper in a plastic bag
Bug Spray
Fill all vehicles with fuel every day (keep them filled)
Have some available CASH
Inspect property and trees for low-hanging branches
Clean gutters
Tarps & Sandbags, if necessary
Chain saws & fuel cans
Flashlights









# STORM HEADED OUR WAY AND WE ARE <u>NOT</u> EVACUATING

 Secure ALL Outdoor Equipment/Furniture
Turn on EMERGENCY RADIO and check
Setup Battery Portable Lighting & lighters (if necessary: candles)
Flashlights
Stage safety equipment by washer
Tarps & Sandbags available
Keep vehicles fueled, Have a siphon available (Emergency)
Run Generator & filled with fuel
Buy ICE and fill coolers freeze blocks (Tupperware)
Prepare AC in the bedroom near window
Freeze as many pans of water you have room for
Fill the Bathtub For Flushing and Cleaning Water
Fill outdoor containers with well-water
Gather all Medicines.
Unplug all unused appliances-dryer-washer-stove
Put toilet paper in garbage bags
Chain saws & fuel cans
Prepare to LAST MINUTE EVACUATE have everything together









# STORM HEADED OUR WAY AND WE ARE EVACUATING

Secure ALL Outdoor Equipment/Furniture
Turn on EMERGENCY RADIO and check
Buy ICE and fill coolers freeze blocks (Tupperware)
Book a hotel(s) *Make certain they are pet friendly
Load Vehicle(s) with the following:
Cat food, crate, blanket, Cat litter & Litter Box
Dog food, crate, blanket, leash, toys
Flashlights & Batteries
Important papers
Medicines, First Aid Kits
CASH
Fuel Cans (Note: to be properly transported)
Case(s) of Water
Clothes for two days
Toiletries
Snacks, Tuna, Jerky, Ham
Few Garbage Bags
Eyeglasses- Contacts
Credit Cards
Drives with pictures of property
Ponchos, Rain Gear
Toilet Paper
Jumper Cables
Spare fuses for each vehicle
Inform neighbors and family where you are going









### **MOVE HIGHER ABOVE CABINETS & SECURE**

Cable Boxes and internet stuff unplug and cover
Computer tower, Printer, Routers
TV
Lamps
Portable Appliances
Pictures cover with garbage bags
Move mattresses to upper floors (if possible)
Shut off any appliances that have a burning pilot light
<ul> <li>Hot water heater (if evacuating)</li> </ul>
- Oil furnaces (if evacuating)
